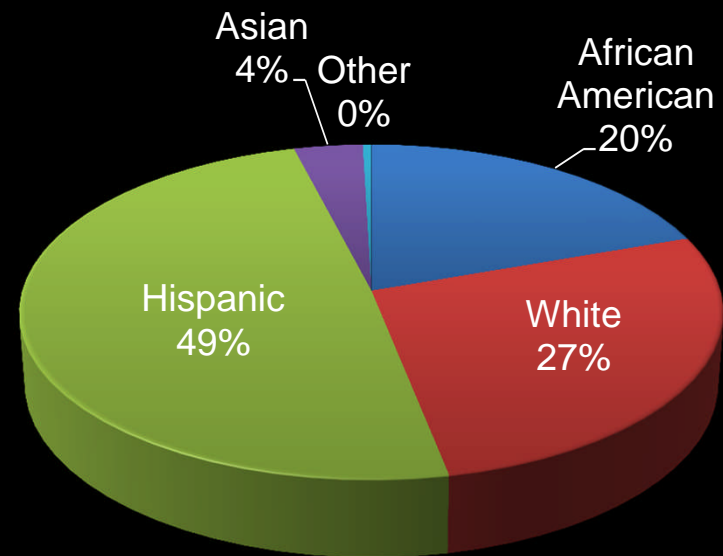

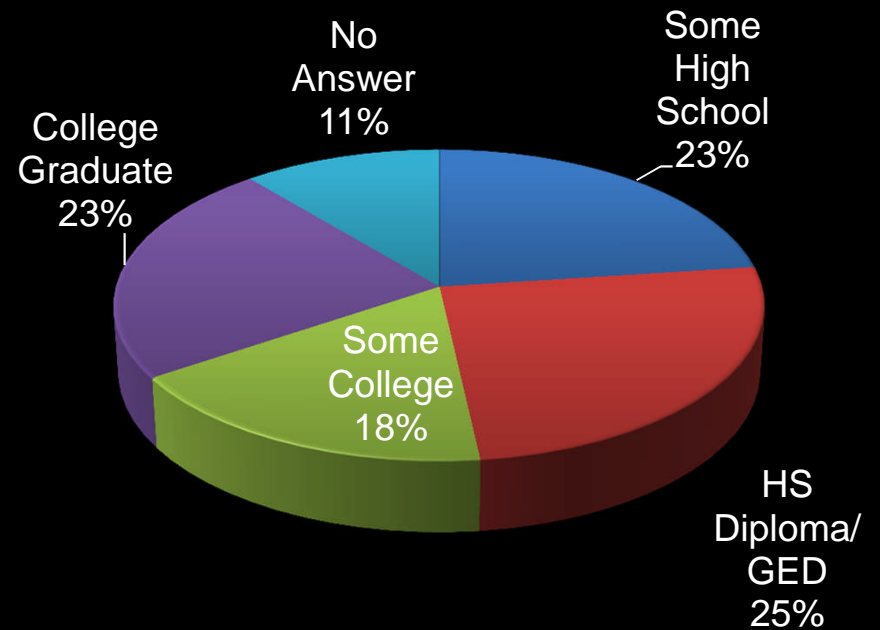


Highest Education Level

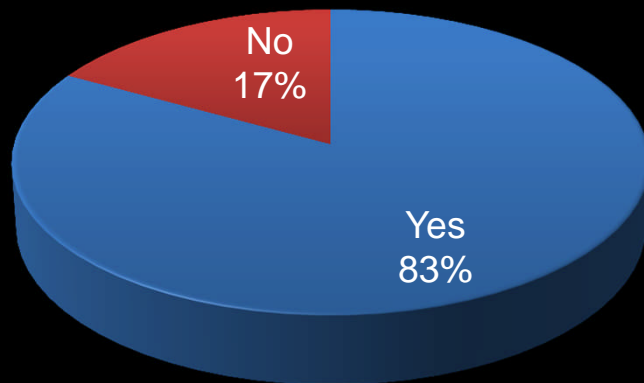

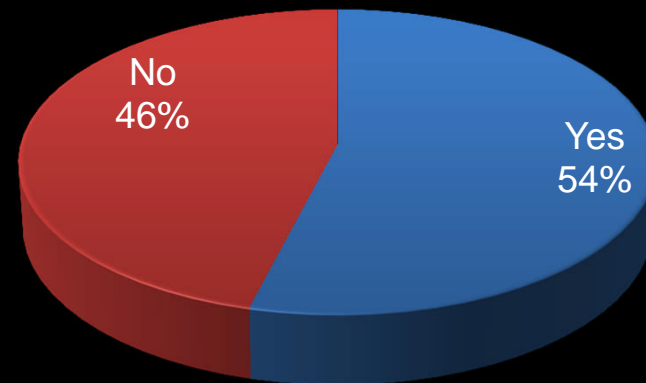

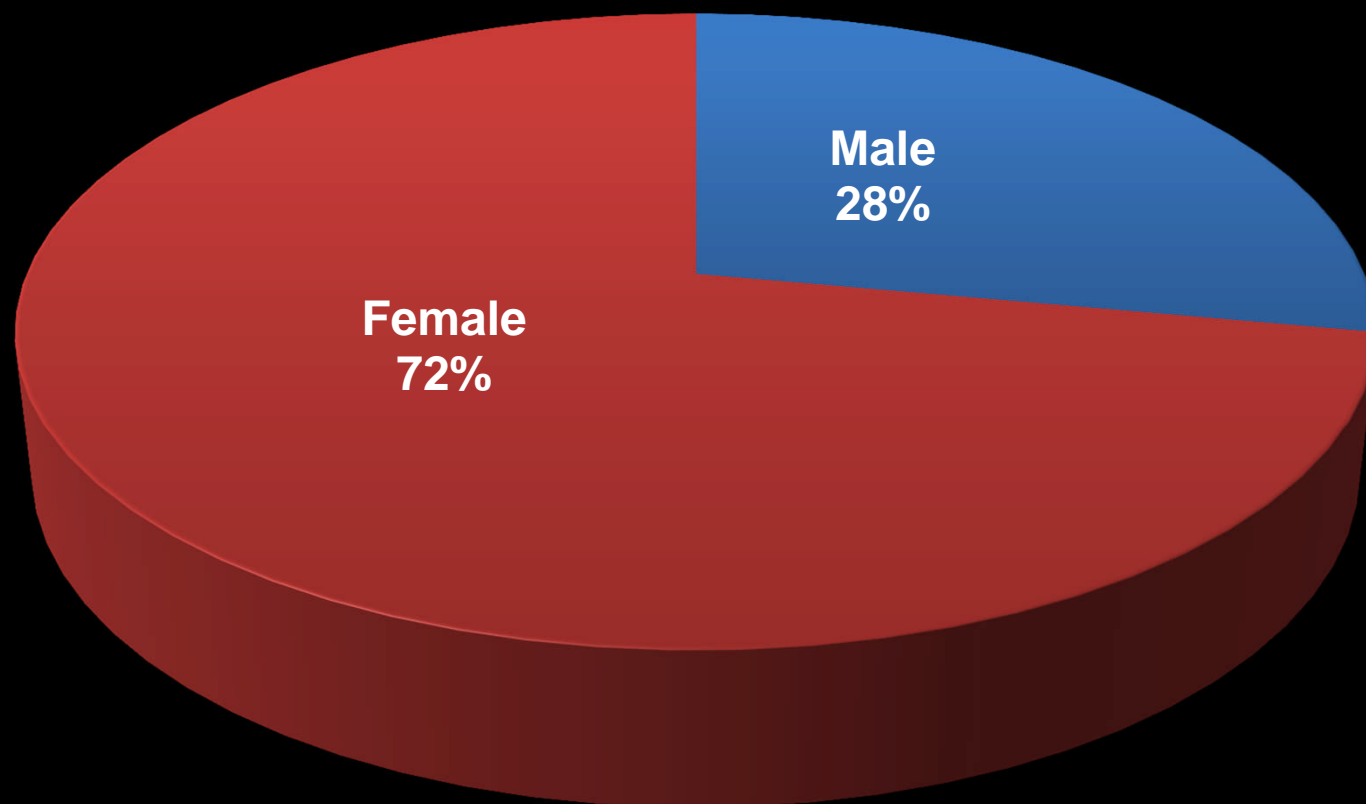
Reasons for limited data collection

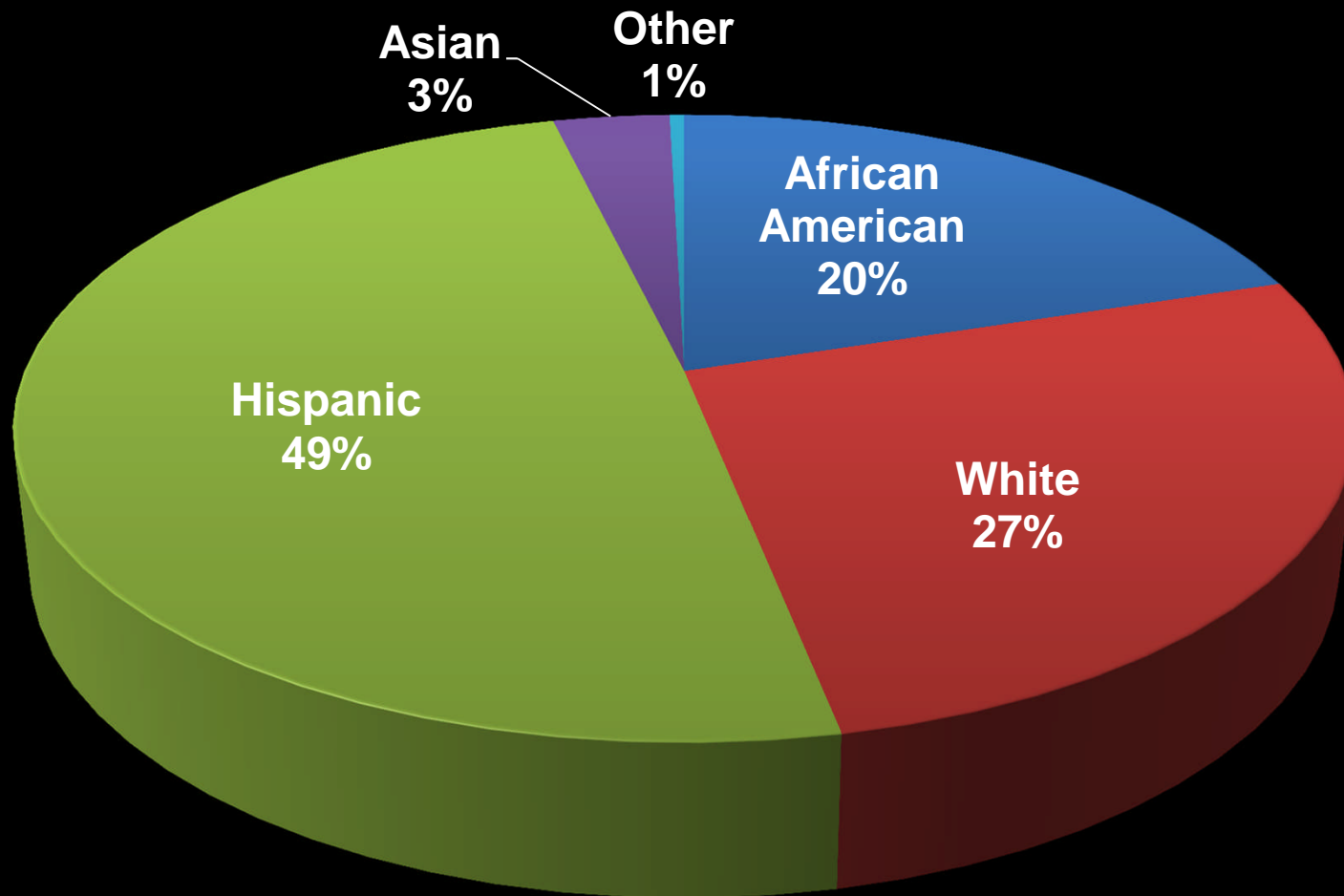

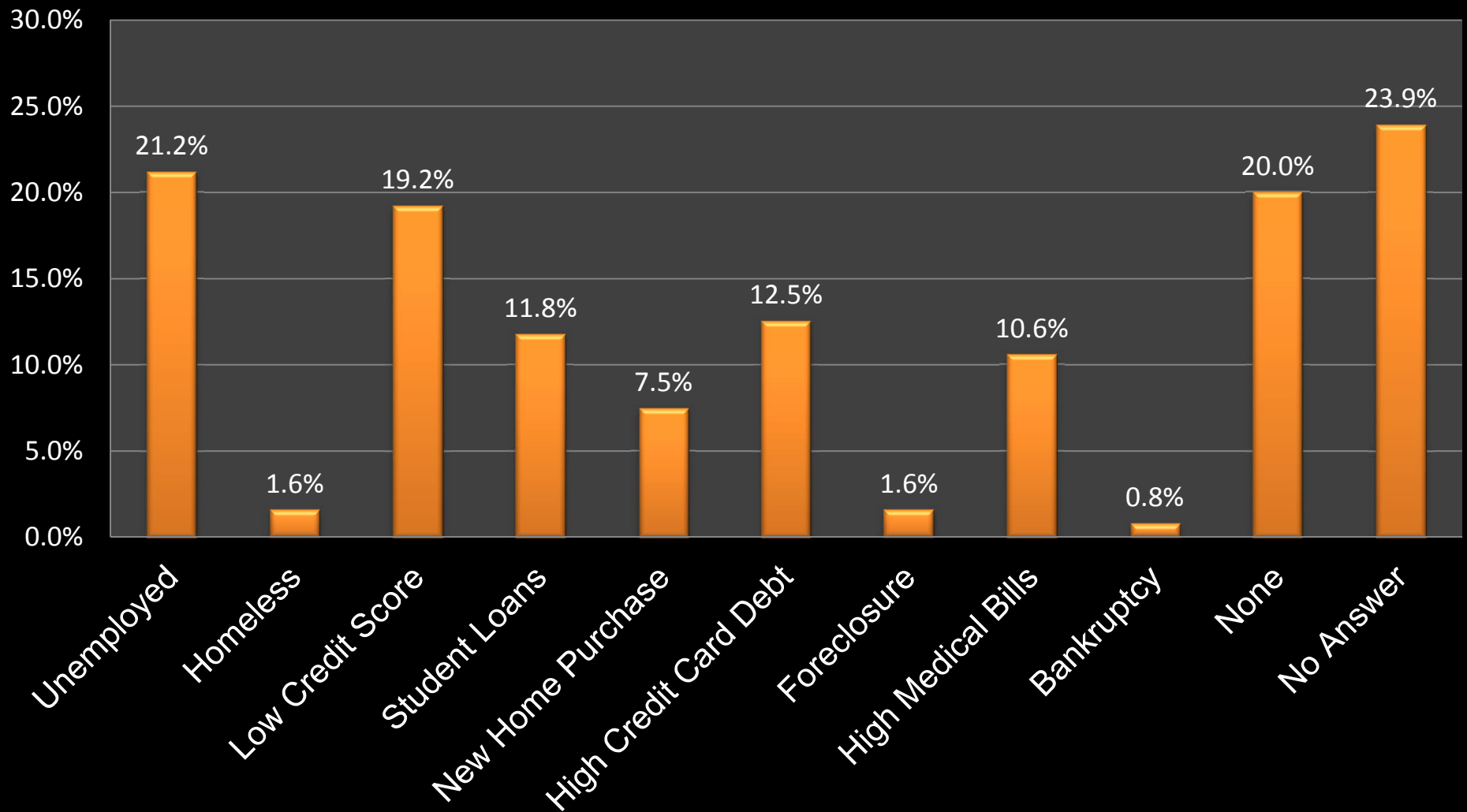

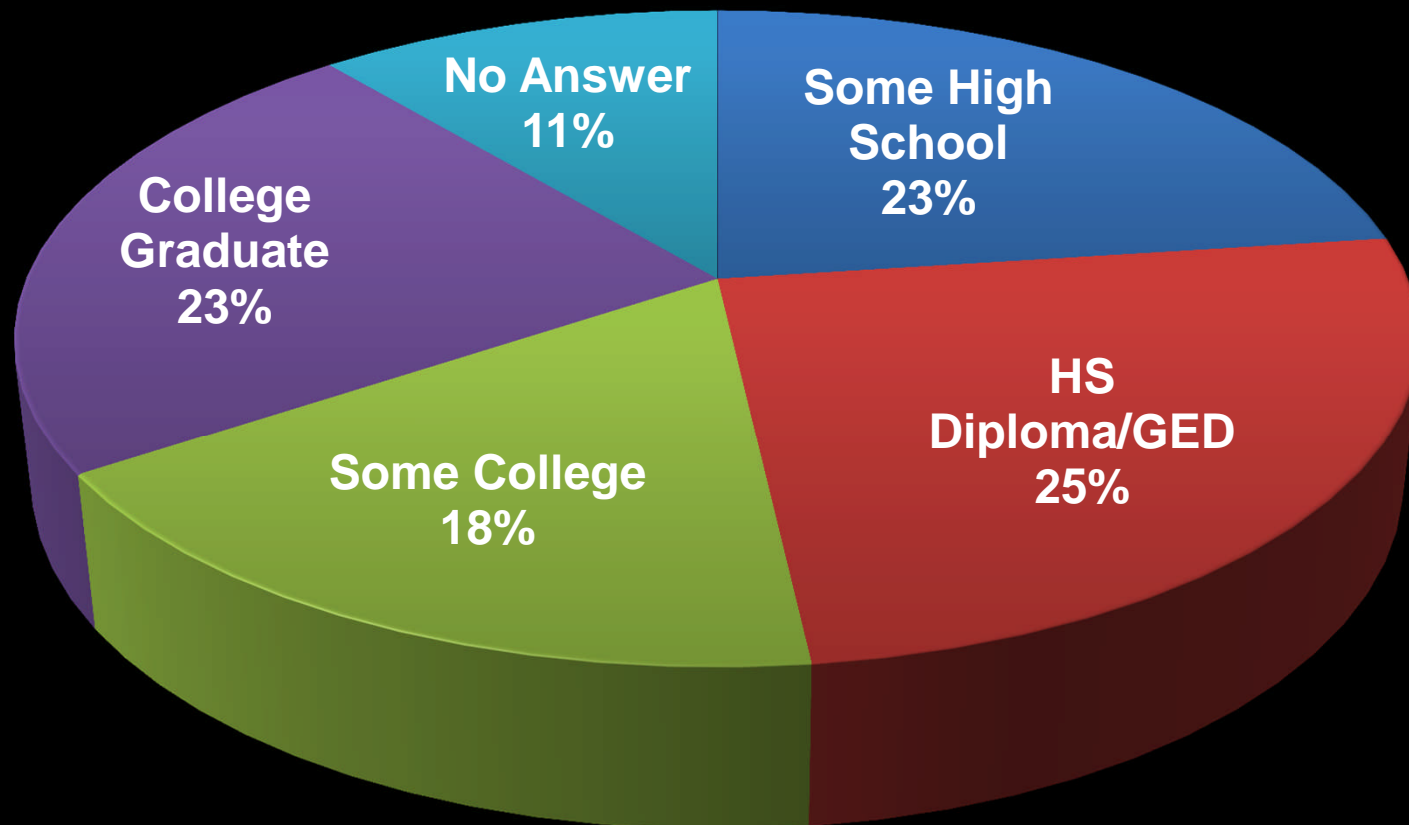

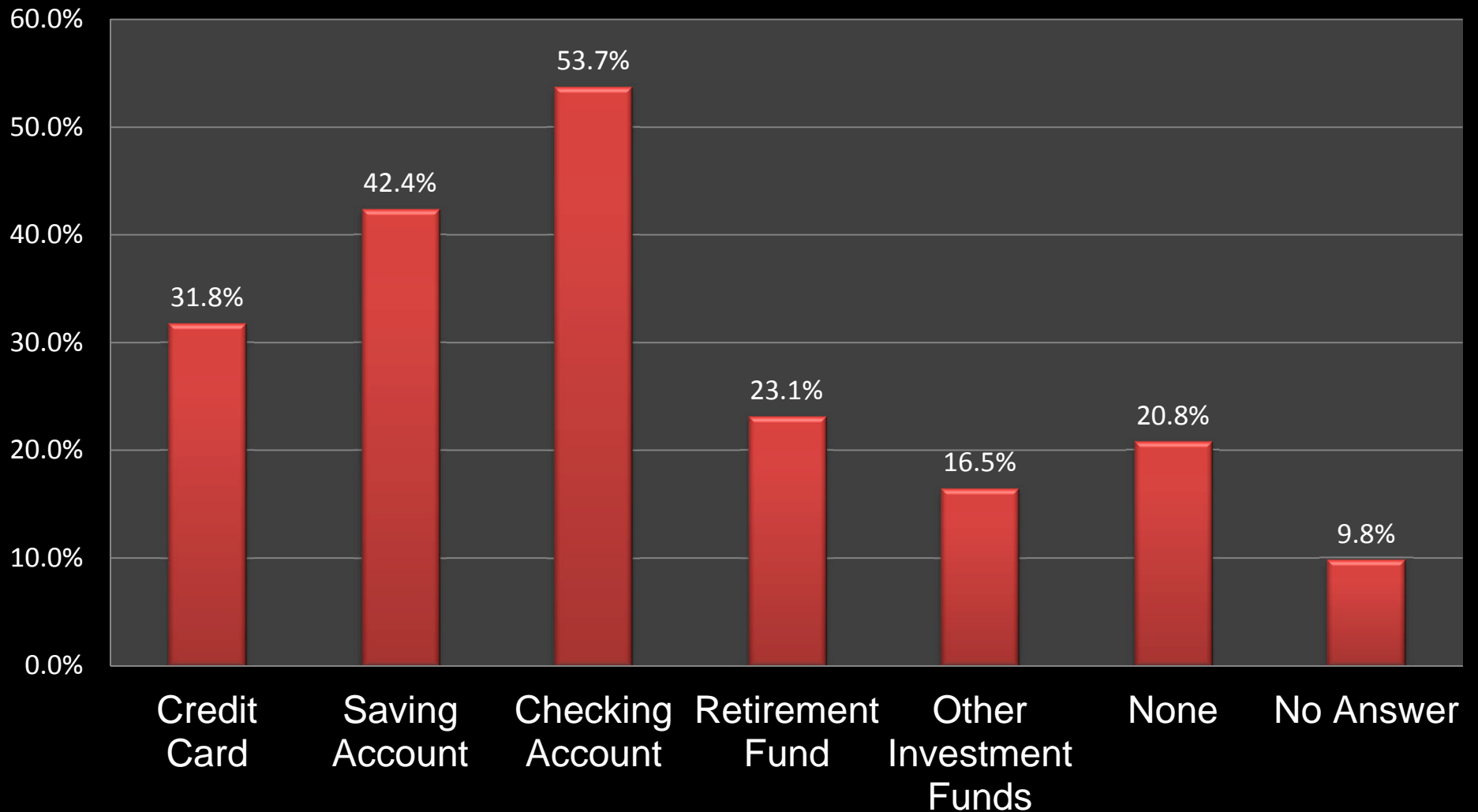

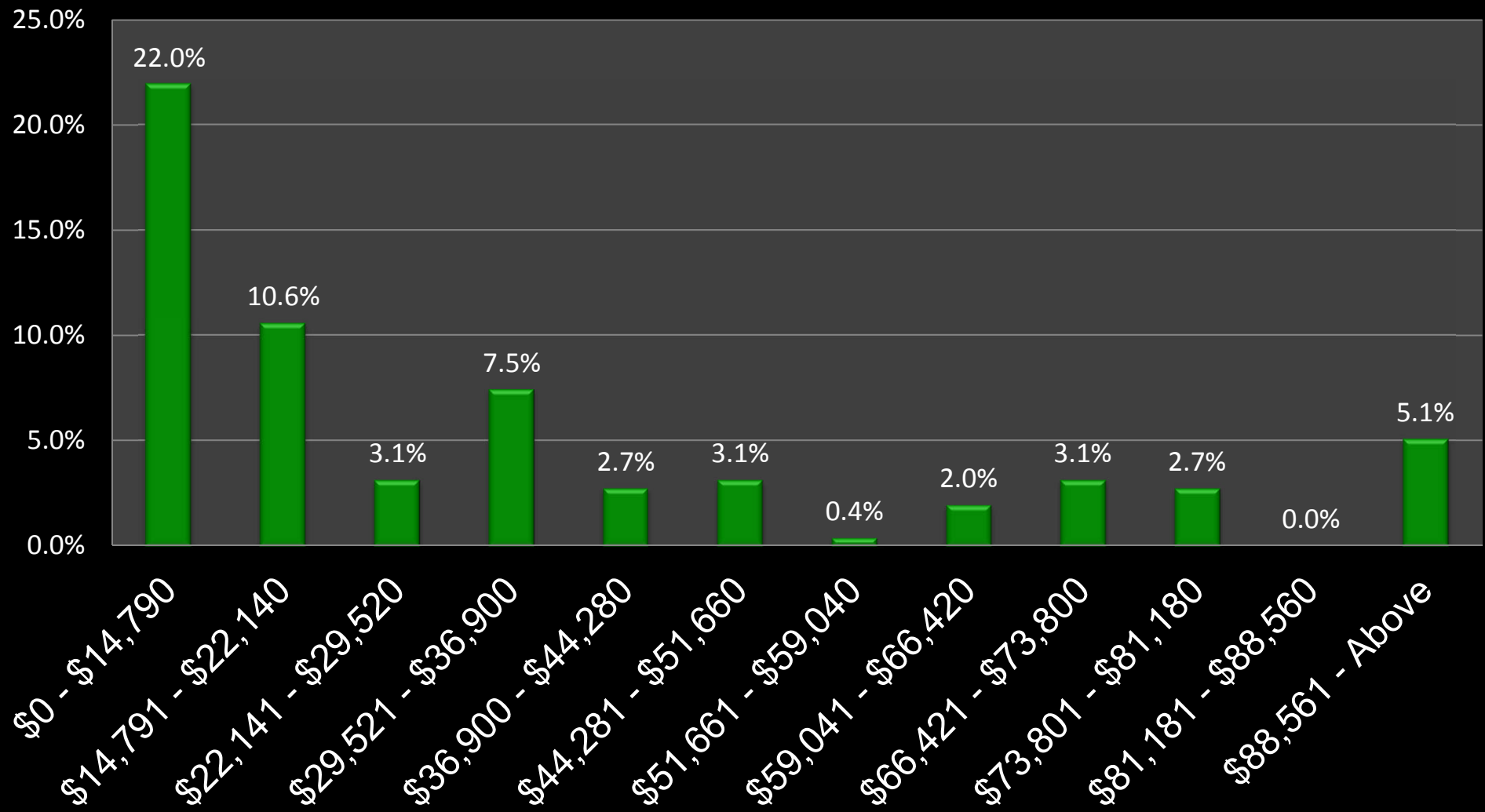

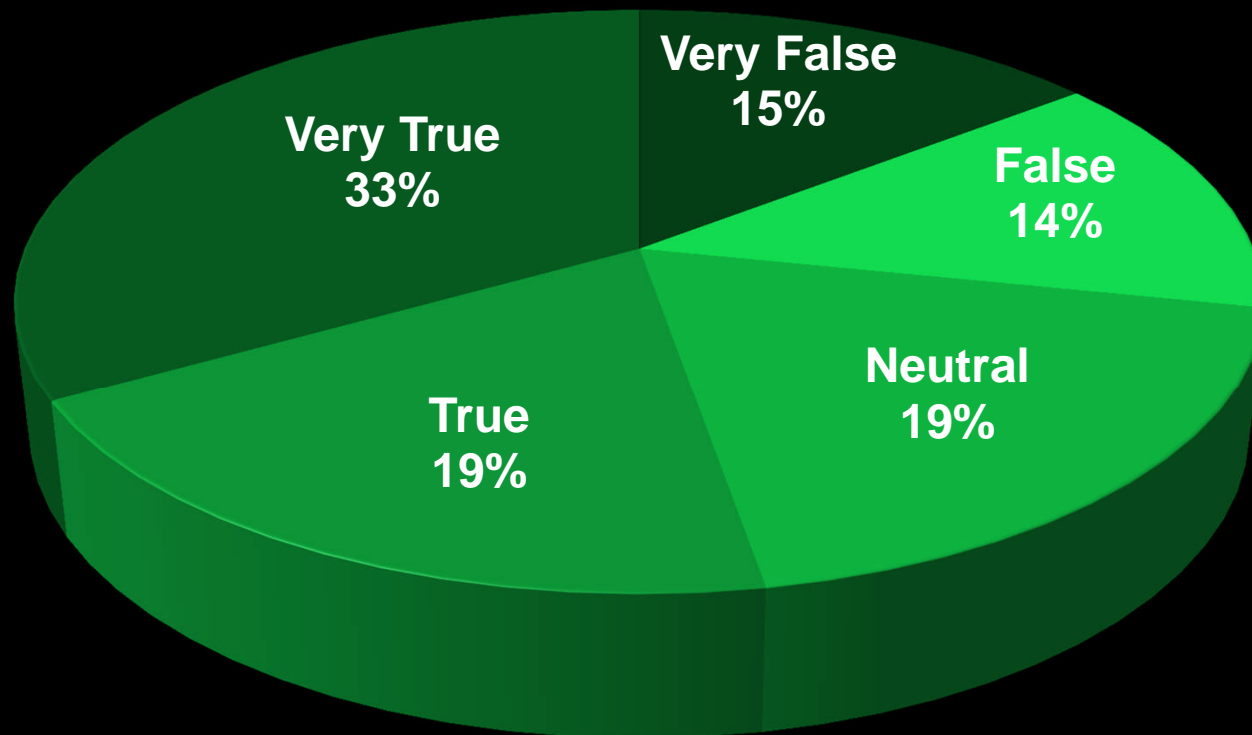

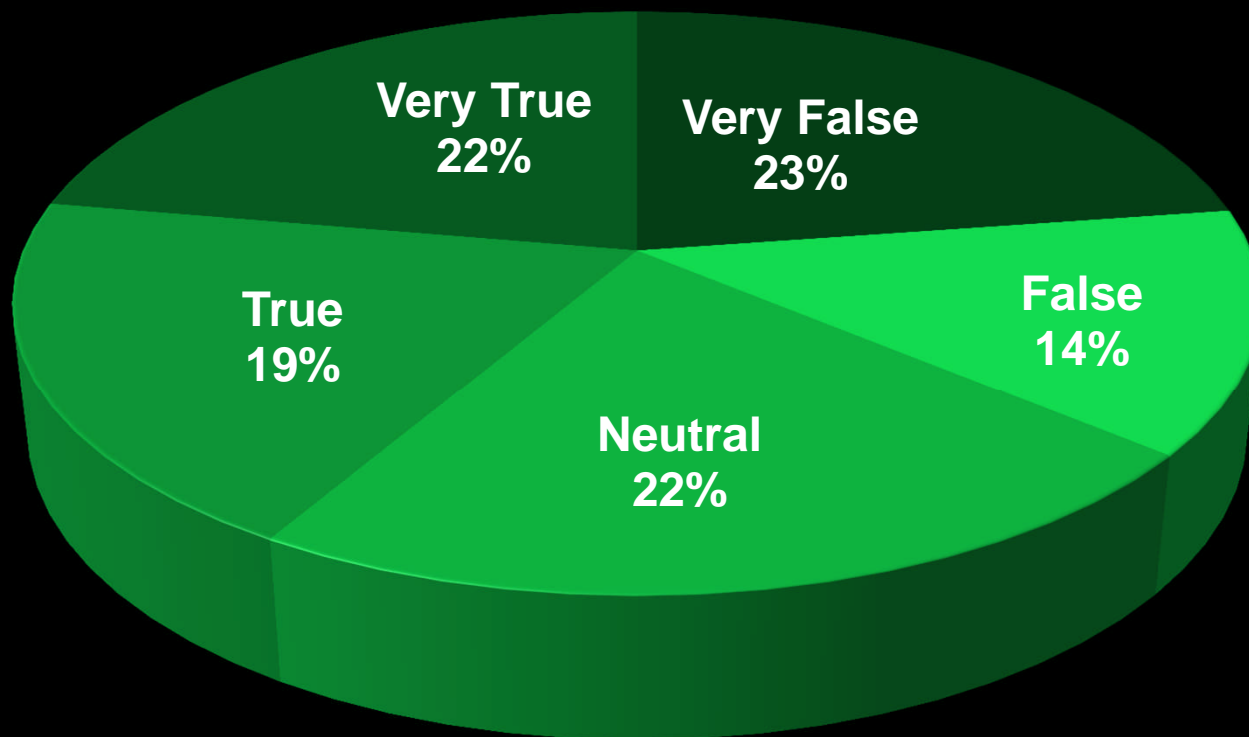

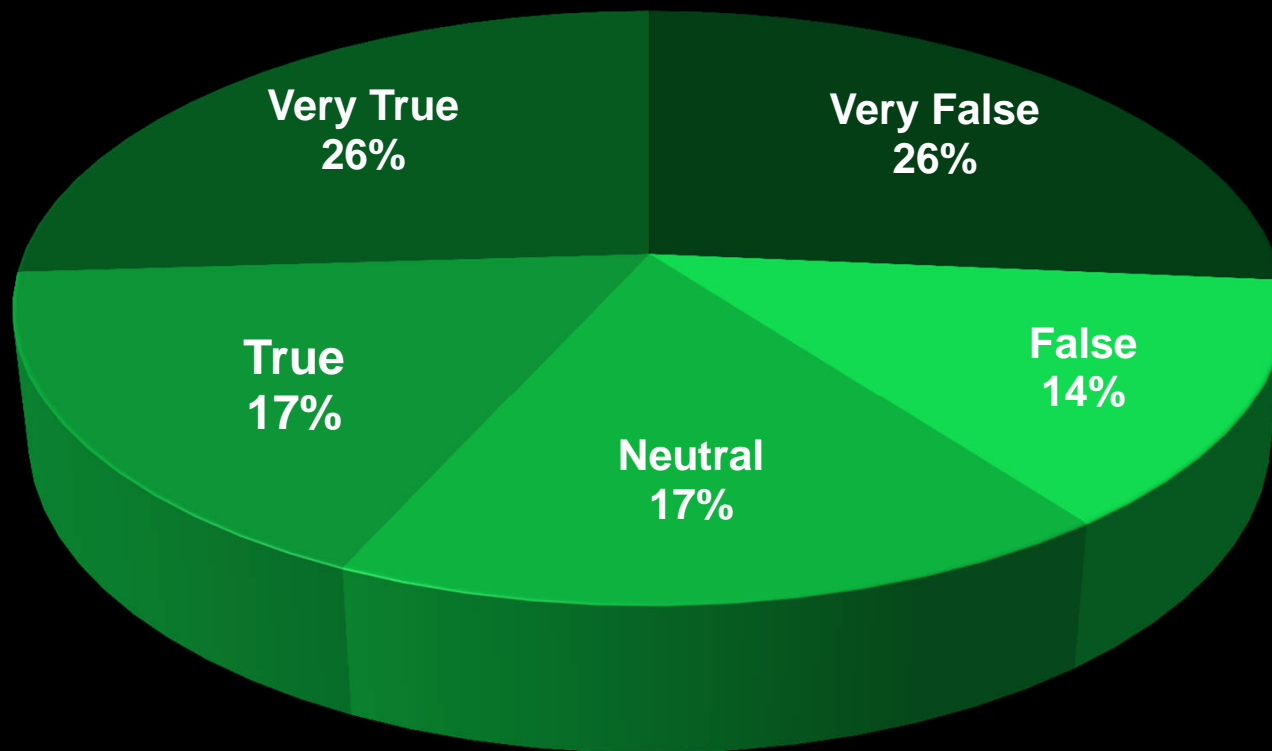

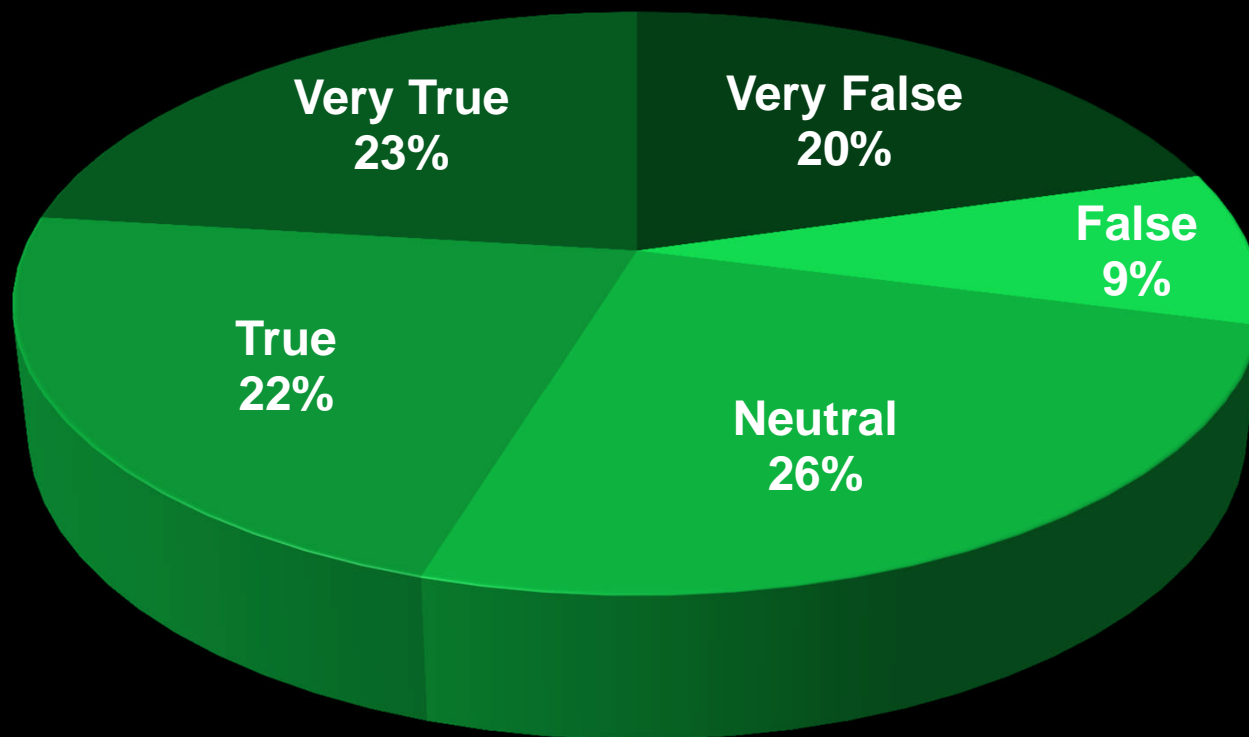

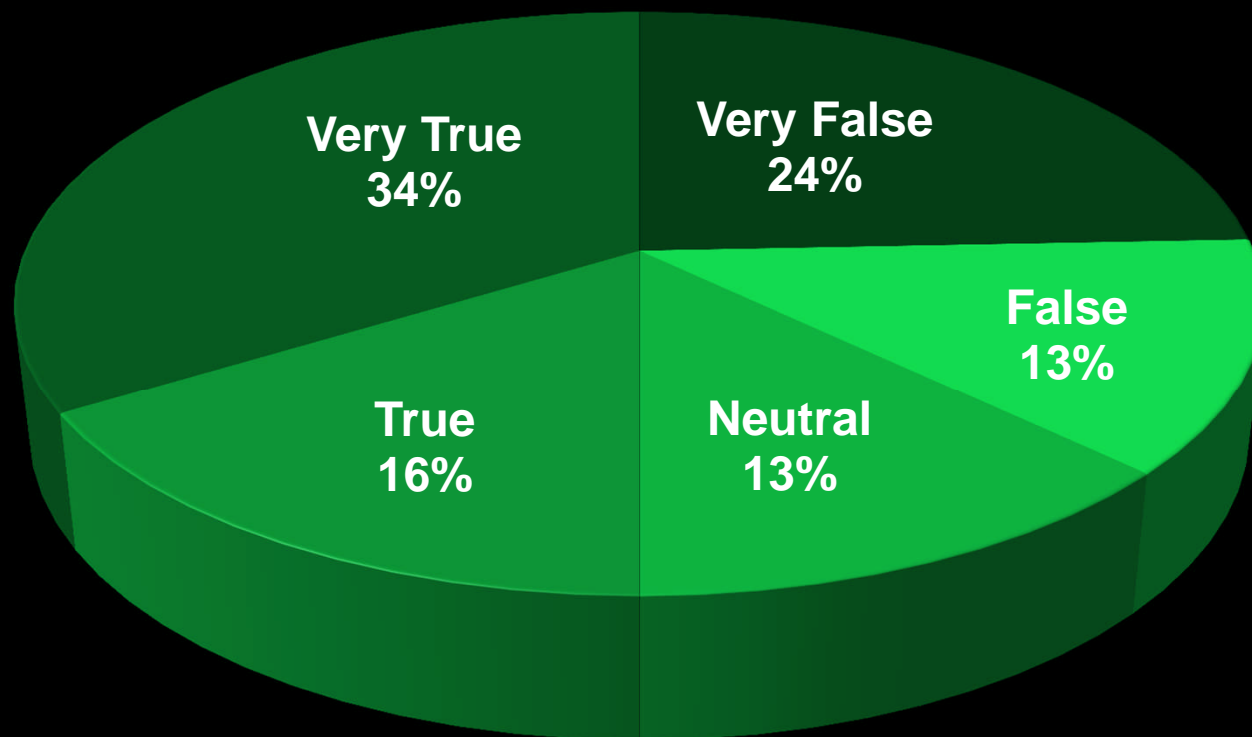

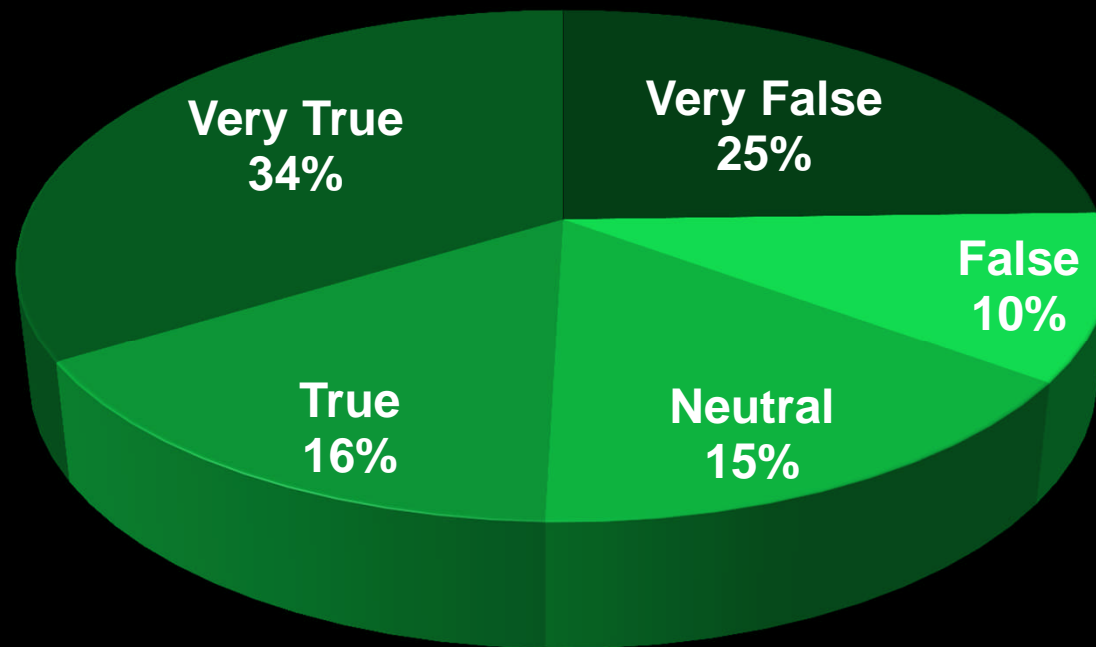
